## **Glass Block Easter Bunny**

### **Supplies**

2 Large Glass Blocks  
Gallery Glass Paint - frost  
2 White 20 Light Sets  
Tray  
White Foam Sheet  
Pink Foam Sheet  
Bunny Face Vinyl  
Heart Shaped Styrofoam (split for arms)  
2 Styrofoam Eggs  
Fiberfill  
Silicone Glue/Hot Glue  
Black Wire Sponge brush  
1.5 yards of ribbon  
Embellishments- grass, flowers, treats, etc.



### **Directions**

Using sponge brush, paint the glass block with gallery glass paint. Allow to dry for 24 hours before applying vinyl. Apply vinyl bunny face to one block with the opening to the block on the bottom. Insert a light strand into each block and glue blocks together with silicone glue. Be careful to keep the light wires free from glue. (Note: To change the lights, glue will have to be cut, change lights and re glue.)

Cut ears and ear insets from the white and pink foam. Hot glue the pink insets to the inside of the white ear. Using hot glue, glue a pleat into the bottom of each ear. Using both hot glue and silicone glue, glue one ear to each top corner of the bunny face block at the back. Glue bunny to the inside of the tray with silicone glue.

Cover the eggs and the split styrofoam heart with fiberfill. Form paws with black wire stuck into the foam and coming over the fiberfill. (Note: The feet should be made with the large end being the toes and it is not necessary to cover the bottoms with fiberfill.) Hot glue the fiberfill in place when necessary. (Note: The curved part of the heart is the shoulder.) Glue arms to each side of the lower glass block using both glues.

Hot glue the feet to the front of the bunny, on the tray. Glue a piece of fiberfill to the lower back for a tail.

Tie a ribbon around the bunny's neck.

Add grass to the tray.

Embellish as desired.

Plug in and enjoy!
